ing areas, requiring an eastwest collector to meet traffic demands and connect local traffic to arterial roadways," Abusaad said. "The purpose of this proposed project is to improve mobility and provide improved system connectivity. The existing Conflans Road is a major collector in the westernmost southwest portion of Irving, which terminates at

SH 161." Abusaad also gave a preliminary environmental review of the project. The project crosses the 100-year floodplain associated with Bear Creek and its tributary. The proposed project would permanently impact 1,085 linear feet (0.24 acre) of the intermittent tributary to Bear Creek and approximately 7.86 acres of Crosstimbers Woodland and Forest and 1.32 acres of river vegetation. Abusaad stated there would be no significant environmental impact resulting from this project.

Jim O'Connor, transportation manager for the City of Irving, said this project has been in the works for Irving for quite some time.

"[This extension] has appeared on the master thoroughfare plan I believe every year for the past 27 years," O'Connor said. "We've seen the need for this for a long time to open up southwest Irving for development. You

can see it happening even now, there's a lot of activity out there. The coming of the George Bush Turnpike has just accelerated it.

"To get from eastern Irving to western Irving and on into Arlington and Fort Worth right now, the only choices you have are 183 or go down to Rock Island Road and from there go south to Carrier Parkway. It's just not very convenient to go from east to west right now. Through its connection to FAA Boulevard, this extension will tie into FAA which continues all the way over into 360, which eventually will go all the way to 820 over in Fort Worth. It's a great cross-town route."

O'Connor hopes the project will ultimately provide travelers with a more convenient route to get from east Irving to west Irving.

However, even in these early stages some residents have reservations about the project. One Irving resident, James Shultz, is concerned about not only the increase in traffic, but the potential increase in noise affecting the residential areas around Conflans and Bear Creek.

"I cannot stress enough the traffic noise that comes from the 18-wheelrs coming up and down Conflans from the belt of 161," Shultz said. "As you go into the other side from FAA and their

businesses, Conflans will have even more traffic from truckers. I'm all for transportation and shipping, but the heavy traffic between there is not a good fit."

Shultz also made the suggestion that 18-wheelers not be allowed to travel on the new extension.

After the public hearing, the next step is for the project to receive an environmental clearance, which is expected to take place August of the year. Construction on the roadway extension is scheduled to begin in 2023, and the project is expected to be completed in
